There is reason for hope because time and again God's grace shatters our crutches and breaks through our defenses, which betray our lack of faith in the divine promises. We believe that a strong military defense will insure the survival of Christian civilization, whereas God can keep His church alive and even vigorous in the midst of social and political upheaval...the church will never master the world until it breaks with the confusion and vacillation that reigns in the world. The church will never include the world until it excludes the misconceptions that hold the world in bondage... With the crumbling of the institutional churches and the shaking of the foundations of Western culture a new church will emerge - purified of cultural accretions and darkness of the modern age is a passage way to the new world eon, when the kingdom of God will be revealed in all its glory. The end of the world signals a new beginning. Humanity needs to sink in death and despair before it is ready for a new and perhaps the final outpouring of the Holy Spirit

Keep yourself from the sin of despair. It dishonors God, the Cross, and the Resurrection. Jesus has already destroyed evil at its core. D-day was Calvary. V-E day is just ahead. Watch Him. Watch FOR Him.
