Righteousness and justice. In both Greek and Hebrew these words are the same (even though the Hebrew word for justice - *mishpat* - has a different root, which we have explained previously). It gets very confusing for English speakers. We have two different words in English because we can speak of one being righteous, but we do not have a way of saying how an unrighteous person is made righteous. We go to the Latin/French root that ends up becoming the word justify: that which acquits, or declares not guilty, or clears the record. This then becomes a foggy notion. To be made righteous or to be justified, we think just means something like being given a legal declaration that only covers over our sinful self. We then stand behind a legal decree in our favor which doesn't really change us, but only covers us with the righteousness of God: we believe that is our justification. To make it more confusing, there is some truth to certain aspects of that otherwise foggy idea.

We ARE guilty of sin and we need to be righteous. Yet we don't have a good grip on what the Scriptures mean by the righteousness of God or our justification. We say things we think are clear and biblical, but which form a wrong view of the love and character of God. We say we don't want justice from God because we only want mercy. But the Scriptures makes no such division between justice and mercy. God is not in a struggle between two opposite natures in Himself. To be just is to act justly. Love is not unjust. Justice is not unloving. Both justice and mercy are His RIGHTOUS act.

This can lead to all sorts of unjust sentiments and behaviors. We say we want justice. But often what we really want is revenge. The righteousness of God is not God's moral purity. It is God's saving ACTION. He acts justly to manifest His love in saving action against evil. We are made righteous (made right with God) in our relationship to Him, while He works in us by His Spirit to bring us out of evil behaviors, desires, and thoughts, and causes us to become LIKE Him.


This is true SALVATION. It is far above the weak and confusing idea of a mere legal cover-up. He who has begun this good work in us will bring it to completion. We therefore continue our audio message this month dealing with the many-sided question of true righteousness and justice. The more we understand, the more we will move in the opposite spirit into the unrighteous world around us. The love of God through us will act justly to bring what is right.


Closing Thoughts...
