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Closing Thoughts



Dear Friends,



I resist doing audio teachings in Nightlight that require an extended series. Usually topics that may require more than one hour will not exceed three sessions. Yet the current teaching on the imagination is an exception. Why?

I am aware in myself, and in so many I try to help, that we all suffer from a terrible mental malady. We think we know a subject if we have heard a sermon on it once, or read a bit about it, or listened to a tape, CD, or now mp3. We think we have it! No, we just heard an introduction. We form this false idea of hearing and not engaging or doing, from listening to sermons. I am thankful for sermons (good ones, that is). But I have been aware for decades that hearing and never doing is not only fruitless for long term change, but is actually detrimental to it. For as James tells us, to be hearers and not doers causes self deception. We end up being full of partial information and calling that mental cartoon, awareness.

When I deal with people who are suffering mentally from depression, compulsive thoughts, lusts, painful memories, or romantic confusion (to name a few), I find they are looking for something different than the message that ad-

dresses their pain. They have already 'heard that' and 'it didn't work.' So they are on to the next gimmick, or new teaching, or whatever. As Chesterton said of Christianity as a whole, "It is not that it has been tried and found wanting, but it has been found difficult and therefore never been truly tried." Let's apply this to addressing mental suffering at the Cross. We want a painless, even effortless mental exercise homogenized into a method. We are afraid of the Holy Spirit taking us any place we are not able to control. We may allow some prayer into the struggle, but we may or may

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not realize that we have our self protections so firmly in place we refuse God entrance. We disallow our real issue with its core pain to rise up into the Light. So we 'tried it and it didn't work.' Then we move on to the next thing.

We also cannot work on our mental pain in isolation. We not only are healed in listening prayer, but in fellowship, study, and just plain living and engaging with others in Christ. We cannot pick and choose. We have to take the whole treatment, and that for a lifetime. So that is why we are spending an unusual amount of time on the subject of the imagination.

Here is GOOD NEWS! There is the real God who is waiting for us to come to Him on His terms. He will help us deal with real things in His Presence. And when we engage with Him concerning them, there will be healing grace that brings true and lasting change in the mental strongholds that have kept us sick, lustful, depressed, confused, lonely, grieving, hurt, fearful, raging, etc. Don't look ahead for the new thing. Go back to the old ways, revisit the ancient paths. You will find rest for your souls.

I got several knocks upside my head from some of you over the Zombie review. I guess I didn't get my heartfelt emotions across over the soft gentle side of the film which I did genuinely see in it. But... we will move forward...


> retired and no longer able to work. But her work goes on 24/7, not only through these classic books, but also in the many lives she has transformed by her loving investment, my own among them!
